Then you can cut wool from sheep. If you reproduce next to the village, you can hide there. The village also has woolly blocks on top of poles from a wooden fence. Don't feel bad to make that wave, but be sure to replace the torches. Then craft a bed and sleep. This reduces night time by a lot. Lot.
